



# Neuronyx<sup>2</sup>

The goal of the game is to match cards in as short a time as possible.

In certain games, the cards must be matched in order (card-A before card-B). This is indicated in the title bar: ordered or not ordered.

If at the time of launching a new game you press the Control and Command (Apple or Windows) keys, the background will be blank (useful for the screen captures).

Hold down the Shift key while dealing or flipping the cards to slow the animation.

**To import a game**, select its folder from the “Load another game...” menu, or drag the folder (of the cards-game) onto the Neuronyx window. Then click the “Cards Dealt” button (in order to check the game folder), and select the “Import current game” menu.

Note: If you have several cards games to import, you can deactivate the animations via the “Options” menu.

Note2: Additional cards games are placed in the “CardsGames” folder of the “Neuronyx” folder. You can also do this from the Finder.

## Neuronyx is distributed as:

- **Shareware** for **single user**, registering has a suggested retail price of **€6**.
- **For multiple licenses, professional use or school**, please contact me via the link at the bottom of this page.

All functions of the software are activated. A recall window will appear regularly during the valuation period. You can purchase Neuronyx by clicking on the button **Buy now!**, this will take you to the web site [www.paypal.com](https://www.paypal.com) (secure website). You may also purchase Neuronyx by cheque using the form joint.
